

mark or an alternative design agreed in writing by the IDBF TES. The mark itself shall be of a size to fit into a square of 40mm x 40mm (or circle of a maximum radius of 40mm) and shall not be smaller than 30mm x 30mm.

The colouring of the mark shall be in keeping with those of the IDBF logo (or the manufacturer's logo) as shown on the Master Copy of the Manufacturer's Standard Paddle Mark. .

To complete the licensing process and for our IDBF Technical Equipment records, I would be grateful if you would supply me with the following information about your paddle. (The commercial confidentiality of the paddle will of course be maintained by the IDBF).

Your model or catalogue number and a brief description of the paddle.


- A brief summary of the materials, the construction and finish used on the paddle.
- A copy of your manufacturing drawing showing the dimensions that you will maintain in respect of the measurements shown in the specification.
- A copy of your quality control plan briefly outlining the arrangements that will be taken to assure the continued compliance of subsequent production runs.

In return you may state, in any promotional material concerning the paddle or when advertising your company and its products, that your Dragon Boat Paddle complies with the IDBF Paddle Specification 202a and is licensed or approved for competition use under the IDBF Racing Paddle Registration Scheme.
